Gateway to the High Street from Tanyard Lane Car Park

A proposal from The Visitor & Tourism Group of the Partnership to Transform the present entrance:

FROM



A messy, uncoordinated and thoroughly unattractive area. A poor welcome to visitors and residents alike.

It also fails to indicate to visitors that this is the quickest route to the shops.

TO



We have worked with the local architect, to prepare an outline design of a visually attractive 'gateway' to the High Street.

The proposal is for a simple open framework gateway. The front arch will have cut lettering **Steyping High Street**

The roof mesh is a laser cut outline of the High Street buildings, based on the OS map.

The arch is constructed of CorTen laser cut steel. This material develops a natural patina which will blend with the background colours and does not require maintenance.

Double-sided display boards would fill in the both sides of the “gateway” to carry information/advertisement boards in a contained display. These proposals reflect to design elements used by HDC in their sketches of the revised layout and landscaping.

Finance

The Partnership have applied to LEADER (European funding) for a 100% grant and their Expression of interest has been approved. We are about to submit the full application which will require planning consent. We are therefore working to a very tight timetable
