

Steyping Parish Council LAND REGISTER

Memorial Playing Field – registered as Village Greens VG93 and VG65. Bounded by Charlton Street, Mill Road and Mill Lane, with Rublees allotments to the south.

Chandler's Way Play Area – accessed via Chandlers Way. Bounded by Laines Road and Chandlers Way properties. No access from Laines Road.

South Ash Play area – accessed from South Ash and bounded by properties in Middle Mead.

Abbey Road Land – Open space, provided by the developer. The eastern area forms a meadow (and is mown twice yearly. The area to the west is mown regularly to provide an open space for recreation.

Abbey Road Play area – accessed from Abbey Road, with some equipment provided.

Fletcher's Croft Play area – land leased from HDC, although HDC have no lease is available and are investigating**

Norman's Way – tarmac area with basketball court, bounded by Norman Way properties. Area surrounding owned by WSCC. Access area owned and maintained by HDC.

Allotments – Canada Gardens (50) accessed via Newham Lane, bounded by Newham Lane and dirt track road.

Allotments – Rublees (87) accessed from Newham Lane and Mill Road footpath. Bounded by the MPF, Newham Lane and public footpath to Lower and Upper Horseshoe.

Land at Godstall's Lane – given to SPC by the developer, with a legacy for maintenance of the fence and surrounding vegetation.

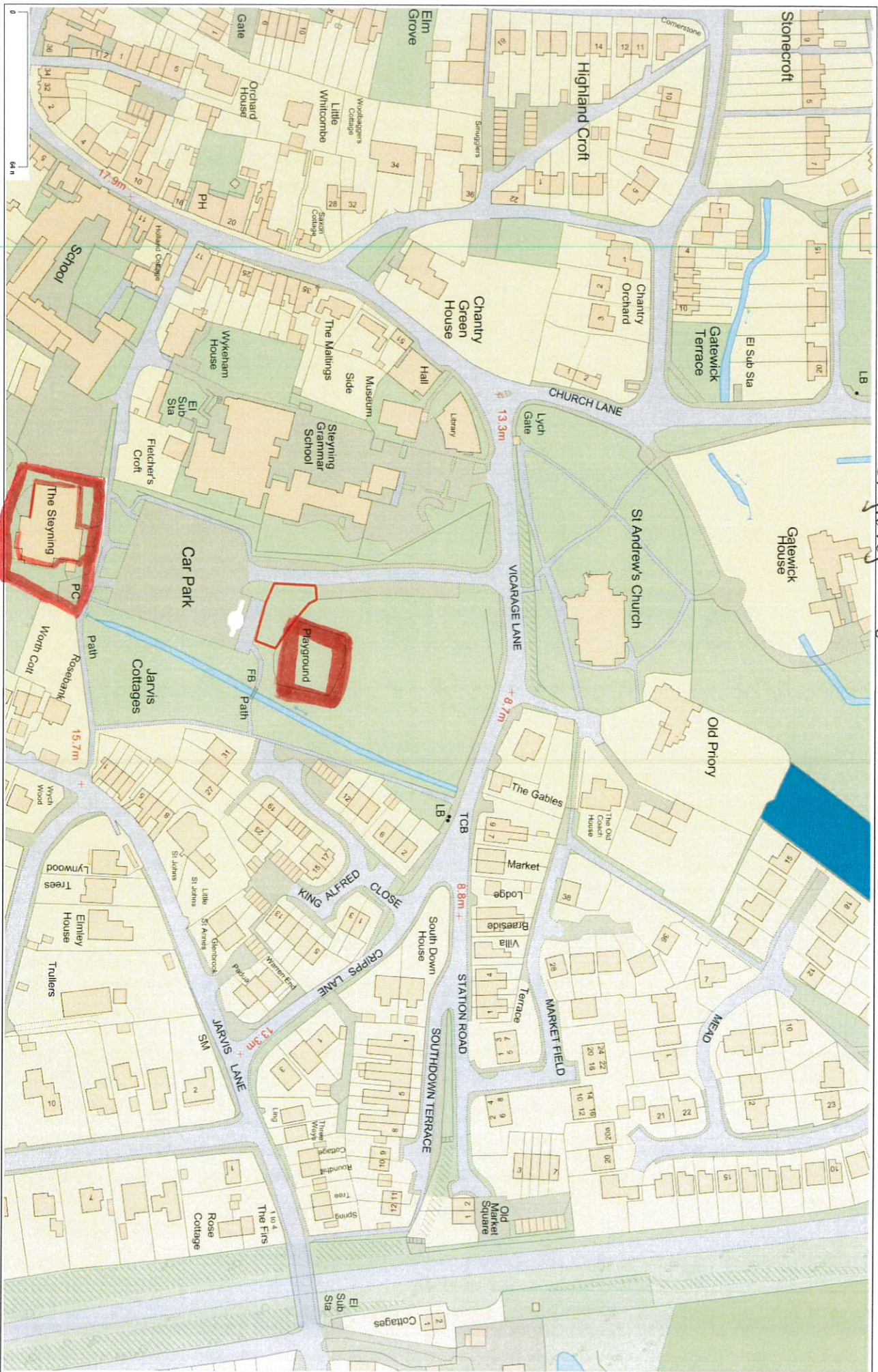
NB Southwater Parish Council recommend Pear Mapping System from <http://www.peartechology.co.uk/> to provide mapping, tree management plans etc.
