The Community Plan Steering Group for Upper Beeding, Ashurst, Bramber, and Steyning, a group of 4 volunteers independent of the Steyning and District Community Partnership, is delivering surveys to each household.

Our four parishes have a lot in common. For example, we are served by the same secondary school, leisure centre and library. At district, county and national level, the fact that the four parishes have clustered together will give us all greater influence as our Community Plan will be owned by some 10% of the population of Horsham District. It will form the soundest basis for seeking solutions to problems, securing grants/funding for new projects, and promoting the collective best interest of our community.

The final Community Plan will be based upon what *you* say in completed surveys. It will aim to ensure community views and aspirations are fully considered when planning future infrastructure and services, and when making funding bids for new projects such as care provision for the elderly, public transport, effective policing, affordable housing for local people, and free car parking.
