

MEETING WITH CHAIRMEN FROM UPPER BEEDING, BRAMBER & HENFIELD

I regularly meet with my co-Chairmen, David Coldwell from Upper Beeding, Roger Potter from Bramber and Ray Ozgood from Henfield, and we met again on Monday 23rd July.

We enjoy a most cordial relationship with our neighbours and often meet to discuss matters of common interest.

On this occasion we discussed whether or not it would be financially feasible to support the retention of the 106 Bus during Saturdays, the overall cost of which is about £4,000, and we have agreed that before taking it back to our respective Parish Councils we will find out more about this from Compass Travel, who operate the 106 Bus.

We believe that this may be a useful service, both for shoppers and for those who wish to visit Worthing Hospital on a Saturday, and if anyone has any views on this would they please let us know as soon as possible.

We are also doing further work on the devolution of minor highway functions from West Sussex County Council, and our Vice-Chairman, Tim Lloyd, is examining the figures in more detail with WSCC, as we do not have a vast amount of information at the present time.
