

MICRO ASPHALT SURFACING WORKS IN ANDREW CLOSE & KING ALFRED CLOSE

We are pleased to say that we have heard from West Sussex County Council Highways Department that some surfacing works will be carried out to Andrew Close and King Alfred Close, starting on 19th October next. This date is only the proposed date and could be subject to change if the programme is delayed, for example if bad weather occurred between now and then.

Micro Asphalt Surfacing consists of bitumen emulsion and aggregate slurry which is laid cold by a specialised machine. The surfacing seals the top surface and improves skid resistance not dissimilar to Surface Dressing. This type of surfacing is often used in urban areas. The finished surface has a low noise characteristics and good riding qualities; as this is a mobile operation it is an efficient process that allows us to reduce the time on site thus causing minimum disruption to local highway users.
