

STEYNING HIGH STREET GETS A MAKEOVER

Everyone has noticed the new re-surfacing of Steyning High Street. Lots of residents have spoken to me about this and all have been congratulatory.

The work was carried out by Balfour Beatty on behalf of West Sussex County Council, over two nights last week and I have written to the relevant manager of Balfour Beatty thanking him for a very quick and efficient job. For those of you who are very eagle eyed, you will have noticed that there is a rogue line outside the post office, which has now been painted over. It was drawn to my attention that this should have been a single yellow line, which had been made double in error and I spoke to the contractors on site, who promptly came up and painted the second rogue line out, including on the zig zag.

I have also asked Balfour Beatty to make sure that the Parish Council is notified in future of major highway works in the area. Nobody, but nobody had told us that these works were to be carried out and we would have appreciated that, as we should have put up more prior information on our website.
