

REPAIRS AND CLEAN TO TOWN CLOCK

Steypning's iconic town clock is going to have its annual service during August.

In particular, the chimes, which have been out of action recently, will be restored and we are going to clean off all the pigeon droppings, and to frustrate them getting in to the clock tower itself we are going to put some unobtrusive black timber boarding behind the louvre gaps. The louvres themselves will be repainted, together with surrounding wood and metal areas, and in particular, the weather cock on top will be re-gilded.

The work will be carried out in two stages, with the annual service taking place during August, including the chime restoration, and the remaining works being scheduled for the first week in September. The total cost of all these works is approximately £3,000.
