

NO CHANGE TO STEYNING IN PARISH COUNCIL REVIEW

Horsham District Council has now published its review of the governance of parish councils generally.

They have considered a large number of representations concerning the number of parish councillors in each locality and we are pleased to note that generally speaking there is no change and certainly no change envisaged for Steyning ie it will remain as 15 parish councillors.
