

SEVERE WEATHER MANAGEMENT

Once again the Parish Council has a severe winter weather management plan in place and will ensure (with the help of WSCC) that the High Street grit bins remain filled. We expect the same number of grit bags to be delivered around the Town this year as in previous years when/if there is a severe weather warning from WSCC.

We also have a contractor on standby to clear strategic roads should snowfall be sufficiently heavy. We would ask once again that residents help elderly or less able neighbours if they are able to do so, with clearing or gritting paths etc.

Vicarage Lane opposite St. Andrews church on grass/Fletchers Croft Car Park

Corner of Jarvis Lane and Holland Road on grass verge by telegraph pole

At crest of Penlands Vale

On grass at top of Hills Road/Ingram Road - previously at top of Laines Road

Kings Barn Lane near to road over the by-pass next to the electricity sub station

Tanyard Lane/Breach Close

Corner of Bramber Road/Goring Road on grass verge

Corner of Andrew Close/Ingram Road

Bottom Hills Road/Newham Lane - previously part way along Hills Road

Roman Road/Kings Stone Avenue by telephone box.
