

UK POWER NETWORKS – WORKS IN STEYNING AND BRAMBER – UPDATE

I have been keeping in regular touch with UK Power Networks and it now appears that the start of the works in the Steyning and Bramber areas is going to be at least the end of June because of difficulties over partial closure of the A283 and closure of the Maudlin Lane section.

Therefore UK Power Networks is going to open the first joint bay in a paddock behind Annington Nurseries, Annington Road. This will be open for about 10 weeks but will involve little difficulty for residents as the work will be going out into the Downland towards Worthing rather than in the other direction. There will be a need to occasionally deliver large pieces of plant and equipment and cable drums to the site, but this should be no more than once a day and not necessarily every day.
