Criminal damage
Alerted by Councillor Goldsmith about Damage to Shop C.C.T.V. in Steyning High Street .Footage shows male in his late 20's with goatee beard urinating and damaging apparatus. We have visited the shopkeeper but do not recognise the individual. The incident has been reported to the police.
Anti-social behaviour
Words of advice given to young male discarding litter in Fletchers Croft. Instructed him to pick it up and put it into the bin. Resident called regarding offensive language being used by two adult males in the Steyning High Street Bus Shelter. Report of a possible overnight camper on the Memorial Playing Field. We continue to monitor the area. No further reports of occurrences
