

Electoral Review of West Sussex

The independent Local Government Boundary Commission for England is carrying out an electoral review of West Sussex County Council.

The review will draw new county division boundaries across West Sussex.

The Commission has also announced that 70 county councillors should be elected to the council in future: one fewer than the current arrangements.

Now we are asking for evidence about your local area to help us decide a new pattern of electoral divisions for West Sussex County Council.
