



This year the Steyping & District Food and Drink Festival has adopted Know Dementia as our Festival charity. We have several ways in which you can support this fantastic organisation: **Breakfast for Know Dementia** - in Steyping taking place at Chez Joel, The Sussex Produce Café, The Cobblestone Tea House, The Chequer Inn, Rhubarb Café & Springwells; in Bramber taking place at The Castle and in Ashurst taking place at The Fountain. These events occur on one specific date for each of the venues, when they offer a specific breakfast dish which attracts a donation to our charity (normal breakfast choices also available). Baloo's, Steyping and The Artisan Bakehouse, Ashurst are both including a **special dish on their lunch menu**, which if chosen will attract a donation from the venue. The Pizza Oven – in Steyping High Street Car Park every Friday evening – have created a **Festival pizza**; if this is selected, they will make a donation to Know Dementia. **And finally, we have our showcase event, the Moving Magical Moments Dinner on 22nd September.** This is staged by 4 Steyping High Street Eateries and includes fantastic table magic by internationally recognised close-up magician, Maximilian. Our meal on the move takes in a starter at either Baloo's or The Cobblestone Tea House; your main at The Sussex Produce Café and then finally, dessert & coffee at Springwells. Tickets – available from Sussex Produce Company - are £35 to include the 3 course menu, drinks, entertainment and a donation to Know Dementia.

Know Dementia is a local, fairly "young" charity, which helps families affected by dementia within our area. We do hope that you will be able to get along to one (or maybe even two .. or three 😊) of the events to support them and help us collect a really worthwhile donation, which will be presented to them at the end of the Festival.
