Notes of a meeting to discuss the renovation of Fletchers' Croft Car Park

Thursday 7th June 10am Steyning Centre

Present:

1. Prior to the meeting a chart showing the project schedule had been circulated by HDC as well as a communications plan. At the meeting two design plans were provided by HDC. It was clarified that along the approach road there will be 19 parking spaces (in two blocks of 6 and 13) provided in tarmacadam with 130mm kerbs which will deter cars from driving forward onto the grass.	Action
2. GM asked about the coach space which SPC wished to use as car park spaces if no coach is booked. BG said there could be a local agreement so pre-booked coaches did not have to pay. JF to devise a booking system and look into purchasing an extendable parking barrier which could be put out when a coach is expected. The seven spaces close to the playground were proposed as the best location. All spaces will be 2.4m wide and 4.8m long, so 7 spaces would accommodate a standard 15m coach. JF will request coach park signs for approach roads from WSCC Highways.	BG JF JF
3. There was local demand for an electric vehicle charging point- BG said Helen Peacock of HDC is leading a project on this across the district and he would alert her to our request. JF will also contact her. The charging point would be near the Steyning Centre. As a survey revealed that the current 4 disabled spaces are under-used, it was agreed not to increase this to 5.	BG JF
4. GM requested planters within the car park in the areas within the oval which were not large enough for parking to break up the tarmac. NW felt these may protect the lighting columns. HDC requested that SPC find ways of maintaining the planting, which SPC said they could undertake. HDC also agreed to remove the shrubs which obscure vision near the playground and path and replace with planting.	NW
5. The maintenance of the stream and adjacent grass was discussed. It was explained that HDC Parks had omitted to include the area in their maintenance schedule this year and could not now clear until the autumn. BG to speak to Parks about how best to keep the area attractive- SPC felt the wildflower meadow proposal may end up looking untidy. It was also	BG

felt the sheep may be liable to vandalism. HDC were notified that Wilson Memorial Trust will be submitting a proposal re adult keep fit equipment next to the playground. It was not felt possible to reinstate path direct from playground to car park for safety reasons as it would lead directly into a coach/car park space.	
6. TL requested a small annual maintenance grant to be paid to parishes for items such as planting. BG agreed to discuss with Cllr Gordon Lindsay.	BG
7. The proposed heritage style Ely lighting was felt by SPC to be in keeping with the heritage of Steyning. HDC said the final design chosen would depend on SSE advice about the required lighting level. SPC also requested heritage style waste bins be used.	
8. The existing car park would be kept open as much as possible during the works but would need to be closed for scarifying and white line painting. The project schedule shows works being undertaken in October and November and JF will notify BG of any big bookings at the Steyning Centre around this time. It was requested that the car park not be closed in December as it was an important month for traders.	JF
9. The possibility of SPC installing CCTV in the car park was discussed. NW to notify SSE that one or two lighting columns may need to provide power and support for cameras. JF to send BG the existing quote from Kestrel. NW said HDC use Chromavision. TL/JF to liaise with Grammar School over their coach space and need to ensure safety of students when disembarking, especially foreign students.	NW JF TL/JF
10. GM asked if Community Partnership could be included when signage being designed and planned. SS will arrange meeting with Partnership and SPC reps.	SS

Subject: FW: Footbridge over A283 Steyning Bypass - Planned works

Dear Parish Clerk,

We wish to inform you that we are planning to install safety fence protection in front of a roadside pier which supports the footbridge over the Steyning Bypass. The footbridge, which will remain open to pedestrians during the works, is situated between Goring Road and King's Barn Villas.

The supporting pier is within an acceptable safety clearance from the edge of the carriageway and the safety fence is required to protect from potential vehicle impact which could affect structural stability.

The works will be carried out under traffic light control commencing on 9 July and lasting for up to 10 days. The lights will be in place between 7.30am and 4pm. In addition, lights will also be required on 25 June so that exploratory trial holes can be excavated in advance of the main works.
