Price variation on the different surface colours for proposed Steyning PC playground development

Price differences as follows:

Fletcher's Croft – 399m²

Black Surfacing - £43/m² = £17,157

Black Surfacing with green graphics wear pads (as per quote) - £45/m² = £17,955

Black/Colour Fleck Surfacing - £51/m² = £20,349

Single Colour Surfacing - £59/m² = £23,541

Memorial Field – 331m²

Black Surfacing - £43/m² = £14,233

Black Surfacing with green graphics wear pads (as per quote) - £45/m² = £14,895

Black/Colour Fleck Surfacing - £51/m² = £16,881

Single Colour Surfacing - £59/m² = £19,529

In terms of wear

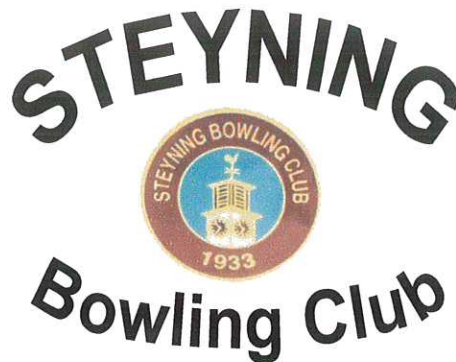
All surfaces have a 5 year guarantee. Colour EPDM rubber granule has a lower wear rate than black EPDM but it is very difficult to give exact figures because of environmental conditions and amount of footfall the surfacing has.

It is generally expected behaviour to use colour EPDM in high wear areas (roundabouts, bottom of slides, under swings etc. But I cannot give you any data or exact information regarding wear ratio's.

However there is a considerable cost difference between black EPDM and colour. The cost of repairing the black surface (say 2-3 years ahead of having to repair a colour surface) is likely to be less than paying for full colour in the first place.

Black/Fleck surfacing provides a good balance between cost and wear.

I hope that once again your Council will feel able to support us and look forward to your favourable confirmation in due course.

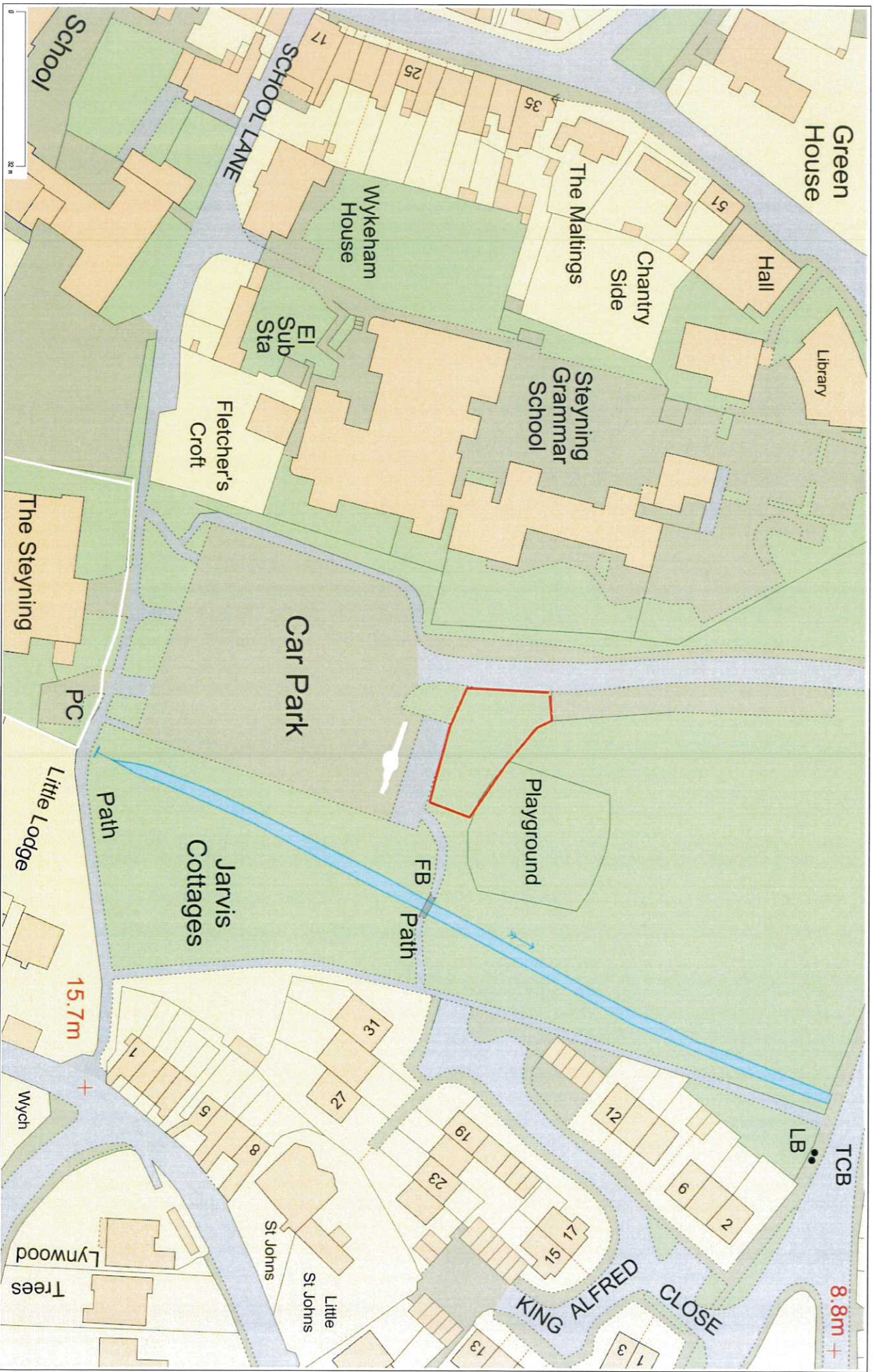

History of 'The Shoal'

The Shoal, Seaford's Community Bench, is an exciting sculptural seating attraction which has been installed in three stages, the first of which was unveiled on 1 May 2017 and the final section in April 2018.

Located on Seaford's widest jetty at Splash Point, close to Seaford Head cliffs, the bench represents a remarkable stream meandering the length of the breakwater. The brainchild of Gabby Tofts, an inspirational gardener, and Christian Funnell, a renowned local sculptor, it is already drawing a lot of enthusiastic attention.

Through generous sponsorship, this stunning sculptural bench has been built to benefit the whole community, becoming a destination with breathtaking views of Seaford Head and Seaford Bay for all to sit a while and enjoy. The galvanised, marine-grade steel used for the sculpture is vandal proof and has a lifespan of 20 years.

Walking in Seaford recently I came across this memorial bench scheme, and I think it could work in the MPF (perhaps with apples instead of fish, and located in or near the orchard area?).

It struck me as particularly well suited as the field is of course a **Memorial** Playing Field, and this would be a way of allowing people to make a tribute or memorial at a relatively low cost (I think in Seaford the benches had small fish plaques at around £25 if I remember correctly). It also provides a community bench and of course raises funds not only to self-fund the project but possibly towards the MPF and/or orchard?

The designers are named on the website, so if the committee like the idea perhaps they (the designers) could be invited to talk to us about the project? Although it would of course be good to have a local artist involved.
