**Subject:** A textile hanging for the Steyning Centre

Hi Hazel,

Further to our discussion this morning, I am explaining ( very briefly ) the idea we would like to put to the premises committee, though I would like to stress that this is just an initial proposal and that if there is interest in it we would then work on a more detailed set of designs and financial plan.

The 'So & Sews' are the core of a community stitching group which produced the SGS400 quilts, which now hang in the library at Shooting Field, and the 'Wilton Park Textile' which commemorates the 70th anniversary of that organisation. Both have been extremely well received but are not available for public viewing very frequently. The group would like to continue to make large scale textile pieces together but suitable places to hang these are very few and we would like the next one to be more accessible.

Our proposal is to make a piece, using a wide rang of textile materials and techniques, to hang from the railings of the main hall balcony. We envisage it being there on a semi permanent basis but would be easy to remove when needed. The subject matter would be, in essence, a natural and built environment landscape with groups of 'people with objects' to represent the many and various community activities of Steyning e.g. growers, makers, musicians, sports people etc.

I understand that there is a meeting of the premises committee on Tuesday 6th march and if it was possible to gauge support for the concept on that occasion we could then proceed with designs and 'business' planning.

I hope this gives you what you need but do get back to me if you have any questions.
