- Call from Chairman of Steyning Parish Council regarding 4 Adults drinking alcohol in the bus shelter. Arrived on scene no trace
- Intel from Front office Steyning Police Station. Complaint received regarding Big News seller outside the C.O.O.P Steyning High Street. Complainant believes Seller is unlicensed. Checked Sellers ID. Everything in order.
- Report by resident regarding male and female possibly living in a white van in the garages in Kings Barn avenue. Will monitor and increase patrols. Resident believes the female is pregnant.
- Intervention. Moved an adult male and female from the Bus Shelter in Steyning High St, drinking alcohol.
- Resident reported two youths riding mini motors without helmets in Charlton Street. Resident encouraged to report incident on Operation Crackdown, and to text us as well if they see further incidents with any description of riders and bikes that they note.

We have had reason to move two adults drinking alcohol in the Steyning bus shelter and consequently check the area whilst on foot and vehicle patrol.

- Elderly and isolated Male referred by Gill Daniel HDC. We have carried out a preliminary visit. We have visited Steyning Youth Club and are working with the new Youth Team to support some October half term activities. Details to be firmed up with Youth Workers. We are looking into booking the Community Bus for a trip to Small Dole Skate Park.
