- Help to find two volunteers to take on the role of Social Connector. They would need to undergo DBS; GDPR & other training (provided by Debbie at no cost to SPC). Their role would be to help individuals, referred to the Community Connector, to integrate in a new group or activity.
- A volunteer to help with the input of Data onto a cloud based management system.
- Under the Community Connector project Debbie has envisaged having **Steyping Signposter** in the community. These people would have a short training session and then signpost those in the community needing additional support, to the Community Connector. Debbie would like these people to have a metal badge and would value assistance in sourcing these, The Logo has already been developed.



- It would also benefit the community if those people with more complex mobility issues could access a Community Transport vehicle with a lift or wheel chair access.
- This might be something that could be looked into with the Steyping Community Minibus group.
