

PPG Feedback for 16.09.2019 full SPC meeting

1. The NHS Coastal West Sussex CCG has awarded the 111 / Clinical Assessment Service to SE Coast Ambulance who will work with Integrated Care 24 to provide it from April 2020.
2. Improved Maternity Services are being instigated Nationwide based on the 2016 recommended NHS England guidelines. The Local Maternity Services (LMS) are keen for feedback and more information can be found at the **Sussex Health and Care Partnership website** or contact cwscg.lms@nhs.net .
The programme is anticipated to continue until **March 2021**, at which point many of the changes will have become embedded as standard practice.
3. The Coastal West Sussex CCG is also running a public consultation on "Mental Health Services" until Friday October 10th and can be accessed on their website.

Isolation & Loneliness Feedback for 16.09.2019 full SPC meeting

1. Debbie Wood (the Seniors Community worker) has received 27 referrals into the newly established Steyning and District Community Connector Scheme. The common theme being isolation and loneliness along with problems of diabetes, dementia and bereavement. The referrals come from various sources including NHS staff and self referrals. All but three referrals were for people over retirement age.
2. After assessment they are referred onto various services including Library IT support; Vintage Years; Coastal west Sussex "Well Being" course; Fitness sessions and all the various services offered by the The Hub.
3. Other services are being researched at the moment including Rock Farm, Washington and East Clayton Farm, Sullington. All services are regularly updated in Your Steyning.
