ASB/Crime/Criminal Damage

- Drug Litter reported & collected from Steyning centre, this included a small amount of cannabis left in the play park at Flethers Croft.
- Engagement including regular patrols at Co-Op in light of continued shoplifting. Staff have our contact numbers in addition to Police as we act as professional witnesses. A member of staff has recently been assaulted.
- Report of suspicious person possibly related to recent spate of car breaks. Sus person when confronted by resident, ran off. Penns Court.
- Graffiti attacks on public buildings and local residences including 6 Motor Vehicles. Attacks took place between 7.00 - 815pm. Locations: Tanyard Lane, Church Lane Goring Rd and Holland rd. C.C.T.V. Footage shows two young males in the act. Unable to identify the perpetrators but jacket worn has distinct markings. Further Investigation suggests perpetrators are from Shoreham by Sea. We have the name of a possible suspect and we have passed this onto Police who are working with Steyning Grammar and Shoreham College to try and identify the perpetrators.
- Vandalism to posts at entrance of Steyning Downland Scheme (Visitor Centre)
