{I have attached last years Cil Report for your information and recent email received below}

My suggestion this year is that the monies received from CiL this year go towards the 'Welcome sign' project.

In case you are not already aware the Council has helped Charles Ashby with this project and our financial commitment was to be £3K which it was hoped in the first instance could be found via S1206 funds associated with Highways developments through an application at WSCC.

Alas, this application was unsuccessful. – The CiL money whilst not completely covering the £3K commitment would go the majority of the way towards it and seems to fit the criteria for its use anyway. – I hope you agree

I write to advise you that, in line with the CIL Regulations 2010 (as amended), Steyning Parish Council will shortly receive **£2,694.86** which represents the neighbourhood portion of the total CIL receipts for your area received between 1st April and 30th September 2019. This payment relates to the following planning application(s):

I have previously attached a guidance note, however please find an updated version which includes our current rates and reflects changes to the CIL regulations which came into force on 1st September 2019 (regulation numbering).

In summary, parish councils are responsible for:

- (i) spending the CIL you receive (the neighbourhood portion) in line with the CIL regulations - to support the development of your area, or any part of that area, by funding:
 - (a) the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or
 - (b) anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area
- (ii) Spending the CIL within 5 years of receipt;
- (iii) Producing and publishing a report on any CIL received in a financial year by the December following that financial year. (I would be grateful if you could provide me with a copy of your latest report by 31st December 2019).

We would be grateful if you could keep us informed about your intentions for the funds as we would be keen to promote how CIL is being used across the district.
