ASB/crime/criminal damage

Steyning –

Intervention with group of youths in memorial gardens drinking alcohol and noise nuisance. Intervention with group of youths Bus Stop High Street. Drinking alcohol and noise nuisance.

Bramber –

Witness Drug Dealing Bramber Castle Grounds which involved a vehicle that had its VRM plates deliberately muddled to avoid identification. We intervened with the remaining group of youths that included males and females known to us and under the age of eighteen years. The male whom we suspect had received the drugs from the driver, ran off and we were unable to speak to him.

Upper Beeding –

Shoplifting at Nisa Store. After reviewing C.C.T.V identified two young males known to us as the two males smoking cannabis in Fletchers Croft Car Park in November. We are liaising with Police and A.S.B.Team in pursuit of a community resolution. We have since started weekly patrols of the area.

Parking/vehicles

Steyning –

Christmas shopping Event, issues with redirected buses in Charlton Street. Issued advice slip to car parked near junction at Fletchers Croft Car Park, Bus drivers were unable to negotiate the turn into Church Street. We consequently held traffic so that the two buses could pull out, reverse and pass through. There is a consistent problem with cars parking at the junction of Fletchers Croft, especially at school end of day. There are new fleet

buses that are longer than the conventional ones and that find it impossible to turn left in one sweep if there is a car parked at the junction. In order to do so, traffic passing along Vicarage Lane needs to be held to allow the coach to negotiate the turn.
