As you know, the public has been providing a service to the whole community by recording the meetings of SPC and its committees and uploading them to the archive.org website. Apart from planning meetings there is a complete archive of about 150 recordings going back nearly three years.

Unfortunately, there was a fault with the public's recording machine at this week's Amenities Committee meeting.

As SPC also records the meetings for minute-preparation purposes I would be most grateful if you could let me have a copy of your recording, preferably on cd/dvd.

As you know, recordings are disclosable data for the purposes of the FoI Act.

While SPC usually uses the full statutory period and more before responding to requests I hope you will feel able to make an exception in this case as it should be uncontroversial that it is in the public interest for the record of the meeting to be available to the public at the earliest juncture.
