

COVID-19 Potential Impact of Coronavirus

We hope that Coronavirus will not impact our Steyning Centre team or our customers over the coming weeks.

However, it is a factor that has the potential to impact our services and as such, we are considering contingency arrangements within the council.

At the moment, we are planning and will endeavour to provide a normal service, but at this stage the full impact of COVID-19 is not clear, with government advice continuing to evolve.

We will obviously take into account the government's advice if and when it changes, to ensure that our team and our customers are not put at risk, where it would be contrary to government recommendations.

Every effort will be made to keep the Parish Council telephone line and offices open with normal staffing levels. Updates will appear on the council's website as and when things might need to change and on Parish Council noticeboards.

If you have any concerns about bookings you have made to hire rooms in the Steyning Centre, please feel free to contact the Parish Council offices on 01903 812042 Monday – Friday between 9am – 1pm.

At this point in time and whilst the Steyning Centre remains open, any decision whether to proceed with any events or bookings is at the discretion of the organiser. Clearly, if the Council decides to close the building for any length of time, we will make contact with anyone who may be affected during this time.

We do ask that for the duration of this current health crisis customers refrain from attending events or bookings if they are suffering from cold or flu symptoms as a courtesy to others.
