

Allotment Report September 2020

The Allotments continue to be busy as the COVID 19 lockdown eases and tenants are making the most of the good weather and extra time that they may have to attend and cultivate their plots.

Of the 158 plots available we now only have 0 plots available at Rublees and 0 plots at Canada Gardens.

Our waiting list currently has 2 applicants waiting for plots to become available. With 3 plots becoming available in the next week so they will be allocated.

The allotment rents were sent out and the new lock on the gates at Rublees has been installed to ensure greater security and a change of combination number. Most rents have now been paid with approx. 7 outstanding which are being chased.

We had a report of an attempted break in on a shed at Rublees and a crop of plums being taken from another plot. A gap in the fence was identified and our contractor has inspected and will be quoting for the repair.

The incident was reported to the police by the plot holder and a crime number given.

Steve our caretaker continues to attend the allotments to strim and tidy the communal areas.

We also continue to advise on social distancing measures at the allotments and encourage all to be alert whilst attending the site.
