

MPF Bin relocation

Following a site visit by Cllrs Young and Alexander and myself on the 11th July there are pictures and a sketch diagram items 8.2.2 & 8.2.3 attached to show proposed relocation sites of the two bins currently adjacent the garden fence of the two resident complainants

At the July Amenities meeting, we decided the following:

MPF Bin Relocation. Cllrs Alexander and Young with supporting papers including pictures and diagrammatic representation reported on possible relocation of two MPF bins.

*Cllr Lloyd **proposed, seconded** by Cllr Goldsmith that the decision on this item is deferred until a discussion has been had with the Cricket club.*

The feeling was that it would be unhelpful to lose a parking bay, therefore it seems option 1b on the diagram is not an option to be considered, however option 1a does not restrict parking nor does it restrict pedestrian access (there is plenty of room to walk by it in the area noted).

If you recall the siting of these two bins has been an issue for some local residents

To also remind you the contractor who moved the bins for us has agreed that one bin can be moved at no extra charge. If there are to be two bins to be moved the Charge would be £180
