

Bin Relocation of the MPF

September recommendation

It is recommended that the original plan to relocate one bin from behind resident's fence to next to the dog bin at the carpark by the cricket club goes ahead.

It is also recommended that the other rubbish bin be relocated back to its previous position along the wall of the Charlton Street gardens behind the two large brick sheds in adjacent gardens. It will be close to the bench again but it would seem that its removal has resulted in more rubbish being dropped over a wider area than before.

August '20

A further visit from Cllrs Young and Alexander as concerns were noted with placing the bin next to the wall of the car park next to the Cricket Club as it was thought this could be hit by a parking car.

It was also noted after conversations with local residents that the bin which was removed from mid-way along the wall of the Charlton Street gardens club had resulted in more rubbish being scattered along the length of their gardens due to the distance between the bin at the exit to Charlton St and the bin by the car park next to the Cricket club.

Further conversations with the Chair of the Cricket Club also confirmed that this still is a much-needed location for a bin.

31st July '20

Discussion with Chair of the Cricket club and Cllr Alexander – concerns were raised that the bin at the gateway would lose a parking space and it was suggested that the bin be relocated back into the gravel next to the wall

11th July '20

Following a site visit by Cllrs Young and Alexander and John Fullbrook on the 11th July there are pictures and a sketch diagram attached to show proposed relocation sites of the two bins currently adjacent the garden fence of the two resident complainants
