

Cricket Club items for discussion and possible action plan Item 8.3

Briefing Note

In the July Amenities meeting the Chair {Then Paul Campbell} reported he had had a meeting with the Chairman of the Steyning Cricket club and discussed five issues – These being

1. Car Park – a report of suggestions for better control of its use to be received by SPC from the Cricket club
2. Noise nuisance – Cricket club has produced notices reminding patrons to leave quietly, but satisfied its patrons not responsible for recent complaints
3. Re-siting of Rubbish bins – Club opposed to bins being placed within Car Park
4. Possible renewal of the Cricket clubhouse: early-stage proposals being worked on.
5. Dealing with a complaint from resident re footballs kicked into their garden – hoping to store goals in a different place
6. Squaring off the Concrete – to be dealt with by Council at a later date

Before the next Cricket season begins it may be prudent to discuss the Committee's thoughts on which of these items and indeed anything else regarding the Cricket Club it deems necessary to act upon and in what way.
