

Allotment Report April 2021

We are happy to confirm that we currently have all allotment plots allocated and a waiting list of 14 applicants.

In the last month we have sent 4 cultivation emails to plot holders who have not been attending their plots.

Two of those who received emails are now cultivating and the other 2 have been contacted again to remind them to cultivate in the next 14 days before the next site inspection.

The Skips have been ordered for both site for the annual spring clean up and will be delivered before the bank holiday weekend plus replacement skips for as soon as possible after the Easter weekend.

We also continue to advise on social distancing measures at the allotments and encourage all to be alert whilst attending the site.

Briefing Note

We need to agree on the number of skips that we are willing to fund / provide as a service for our plot holders. In the past we have had approx. 8 in total for both sites.

The cost per skip (8-yard) this year is £235.00 (not inc. VAT)

At last committee it was suggested that given we complete an adequate risk assessment that we can have a bonfire at both our allotment sites to deal with large amounts of combustible (non-plastic/toxic) material. I would like us to formally agree who is to manage these bonfires and when our clearance weekend is to take place (Deborah has suggested the 10th April as a first choice but if inclement weather or wind blowing in the wrong direction then postpone to the 17th April) and also if members are going to be available to support and in what capacity if that's the case please.
