ASB/crime/criminal damage

Steyning –

There have been incidents of fires being set and hate related graffiti in the Children's play area in Fletchers Croft. We have increased our patrols and fed this Intel into the police who have also set up direct patrols of the area.

Following a call from a resident we engaged with a group of youths who were drinking alcohol and playing loud music in the playground in Abbey rd. We confiscated alcohol from a female who was under the legal age.

We had cause to engage with a group of youths who were playing loud music in the memorial garden and another group at the basketball court on the Memorial Playing Field.

We teamed up with a P.C.S.O and a police officer for a joint patrol of the Memorial Playing field as part of Operation Foresight that targeted youth anti-social behaviour over the school summer holidays.

There have been more instances of youths gathering in the High Street Bus Shelter. A group comprising of young males and females from Storrington are mixing with known local youths to

commit nuisance and anti-social behaviour. All Intel is being fed into Police who now have targeted the area with direct patrols.

There has been an increase of youth related A.S.B. across the whole district with most parishes being affected.

A homeless male in their seventies has been staying overnight in the High street bus shelter. We have carried out welfare visits and although he initially refused help regarding emergency accommodation he has now moved on.

Upper Beeding –

We have, once again received reports of cars being parked in Pound Lane without M.O.Ts. We have asked residents to report these incidents to Operation Crackdown. We have also asked them to log their concerns with Trading Standards as they believe the vehicles are being left by a garage owner on the industrial estate.

We had cause to intervene and move on a group of young boys who were smoking in the children's playground.
