

Children's Play Area Development Working Party Notes

Those present considered the proposed playground timetable of renewal

Cllrs agreed to recommend the following to the Community Committee:

1. That Chandlers Way playground development is to be part of the 'Pocket Park' development and that the Clerk pursues this as part of, or associated with, the grant application to HDC
2. That the main priority for the playground developments and renewals programme ought to be the MPF, and especially as it has a ready-made and agreed, via public consultation and committee approval (October 2018), new equipment specification, costings and plan.
3. That the Clerk contacts the preferred installers (Creative Play) to ask them if they will honor their quote received in October '18
4. That the Clerk contacts the Wilson Memorial Trust to ask them if they would honor their 2018 offer to meet up to 65% of the cost. The remaining cost would be obtained from Cil and possible other grants, to lessen the need to utilise the Councils General Reserves.
5. That the Clerk to schedule the development for Summer 2022
6. That the Working party meets again to discuss any other financial support streams and that if any further support is gained that both WMT and Council percentage contribution is reduced by equal amount
