Successful Environmental Health prosecution by Council

Horsham District Council secured a successful environmental health prosecution at Horsham Magistrates' Court on 12 October 2021.

Mr Labib Fanous, owner of Holmbush Farm, Slinfold, West Sussex has been prosecuted for his failure to comply with a Community Protection Notice (CPN) which was initially served on 12 May 2017.

The CPN required him to not to leave his property inadequately secured against trespassers, not to leave machinery and equipment unsecured at the property and not to leave materials unsecured which could endanger human health from around the grounds of his property.

The property at Holmbush Farm, a former chicken farm, has been vacant since 2002 without appropriate maintenance for at least 10 years and many of the buildings are now dilapidated and have suffered extensive vandalism on several occasions.
