



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of High Street, Steyning CP, 8th January 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic High Street, Steyning CP, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on High Street for a distance approx 65 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 8th January 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 10th January 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while UK Power Networks undertakes Road Closure between the junctions of Horsham Road and Bramber Road with works taking place o/s no.138 for new connection

The restriction will be in place **Off Peak only** from 09:30 until 16:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
