Permission to install a new non-turf strip

We at Steyning Cricket Club are looking for a permission from the Steyning Parish Council to add a new non-turf/astro strip right next to the current square.

The old astro strip is over 15 years old and as such is in poor condition and no longer fit for purpose. It also does not adhere to the current ECB (English Cricket Board - the national governing body of cricket in England and Wales) boundary rules where there has to be a clear boundary of 45.72m + 2.74m run off to ensure a safe playing environment.

In order to facilitate a safe environment for children and adults alike who play cricket matches and train at the Memorial Field, we are looking to add a brand new strip to the west side of the square as illustrated in our preferred supplier quote on page 1. *Supporting Document 2. By adding this new strip, we are not increasing the current play area on the field.

Should a permission be granted, we are looking to use S&C Slater - an ECB approved contractor - to carry out the works as per their quote *Supporting document 2. The timeline for this would be early Autumn 2022 after the 2022 cricket season has finished.

SCC has sought funding for the project and has an initial agreement from ECB for a £10,000 grant subject to approval from Steyning Parish Council. The remaining balance will be financed by the club.

By adding this new facility, we will ensure that the cricket facilities at the Memorial Playing Fields are upto date, safe and fit for purpose and for this reason we seek for permission to proceed with the project.
