Dear Cllr Campbell

Thank you for tolerance and forbearance given my circumstances – that's very magnanimous of you to abide by the ICO's request.

In relation to your Freedom of information request which I will deal with first.
Further to my previous responses whereby I have said that the current Chair and Vice Chair are well aware of the situation in regards this matter, and that it is not a matter that all councillors need to be informed – this remains the case, and it is not a question of being evasive. I will explain more when the time is right to do so.

Regards your request therefore, I am afraid I will have to refuse sending you the information you would like under section 32 of the freedom of information guidance, whereby the release is exempt as it is being held in relation to court proceedings, as there is an ongoing court case and it might prejudice the outcome if any documents or correspondence were released.

I am minded to remind you that you should not really ask for F.O.I and S.A Requests at the same time, but in these circumstances and to save you time, I will say that you would receive much the same response to a Subject Access Request for the same material/information.

In terms of the response, you have the right to ask the Council to review any refusals. In these circumstances you should make your request in writing to me please (including by email) and give reasons.

As you know, because of your personal circumstances I have exercised considerable forbearance waiting for you to convene the FoI Panel and/or make good your acknowledgment at the 15 June 2021 F and GP meeting that my own and other Fols were outstanding and urgently needed to be dealt with.

1 Freedom of Information Act Request

Please disclose any claims since the May 2019 election which have been intimated against SPC and which have resulted in a referral to SPC's insurers and chargeable legal advice. Please redact the potential claimant's personal details. Please provide the response by email. As you know, there is a 20 working day limit for compliance.

2 Subject Access Request

Please provide by email all data about me to which I am entitled under the GDPR/ Data Protection Act and which SPC holds or is processing relating to any claim intimated against SPC or me and which has resulted in a referral to SPC's insurers or lawyers. Please note the one month time limit for compliance.
