

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL
(STEYNING: JARVIS LANE & VARIOUS ROADS)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, West Sussex County Council intend to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to close lengths of Thornscroft, Sheep Pen Lane, White Horse Square, Charlton Street, Bostal Road and Jarvis Lane.

The Order is necessary to protect public safety whilst fibre optic cabling works are undertaken.

The Order will come into effect on 13 June 2022 and will last for 18 months or until the proposed works are completed, whichever is earlier. Roads will not all be closed at the same time. It is anticipated the works will commence on or after 13 June 2022 in Thornscroft and Charlton Street and will take upto 4 weeks before moving to Bostal Road, then onto Sheep Pen Lane and White Horse Square, and finally Jarvis Lane. The works should be completed by 29 August 2022
