A Walk on the Wild Side



Exploring one of Steyning's Wildlife Corridors

The walk starts at Fletchers Croft car park with an introduction and a look at the brook that runs alongside the playpark.

From here we cross the road to St Andrew's Churchyard, to discover more about the new management plan that includes leaving some areas wilder for nature.

We then follow a footpath that leads to the Abbey Road Village Green. Here we will stop at the new Abbey Road Orchard that Steyning Community Orchard has started planting, before crossing Abbey Road itself to explore the Conservation area being managed on behalf of the Parish Council by local volunteers.

Here across 3 acres, there is a mosaic of different habitats, including a pond, meadow, mature woodland, scrub and hedgerows, bordered by the Tanyard Stream, a chalk stream emanating from the downs. Recent bird, bat, plant and stream surveys have shown what a great place this is already for wildlife. A management plan is in place to hopefully enhance this even more in future.
