ASB/crime/criminal damage

Steyning-

Police were called to the Bus Shelter in the High Street due to a large number of young people under the influence of alcohol and causing a public order issue. Two arrests were made and pepper spray used after members of the group got physical with the Police.

A further two incidents were reported relating to Anti-Social Behaviour in the Bus Shelter at midnight/early hours of the morning.

We patrolled with the Police and assisted in confiscating alcohol from underage drinkers on the Memorial Playing field prior to a pre prom party which was attended by many young people.

Alcohol confiscated from a group of underage drinkers in the memorial gardens.

Bramber –

Suspected drug deal disrupted at Bramber Castle. Vehicles reported.

Upper Beeding –

Further reports of damage being caused by someone using a Catapult.

We were alerted to a group of young people causing ASB in Hyde Street open space and carving Nazi Signs onto one of the trees. We know from local knowledge who they are and the Police and school are also aware. We have increased our patrols there.

Joint patrols carried out alongside the Police at the Nisa amid further reports of shop lifting. A particular concern has been raised over a 14 year old girl stealing alcohol.

A resident reported that somebody is regularly sitting on the bench in Hyde Square smoking cannabis, we have increased our patrols in response.

There was an incident where the Skate Park in small dole was covered in new graffiti. We have increased our patrols and liaised with the volunteers who paint over the graffiti. We are willing to help remove/paint over any graffiti if they need assistance.
