Our libraries have much more than just great books!

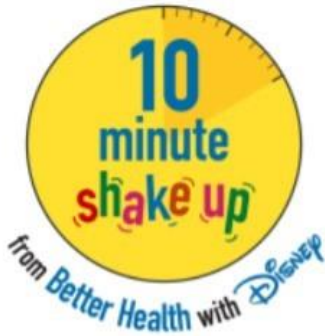
