

Proposal from the Steyning Downlands W.I.

We were made aware at the last Community Meeting that there could be a request to plant a tree from a local women's institute group, when discussing to agree or otherwise the location for the planting of a tree at Abbey Road (as one of two options proposed by the Steyning For Trees Group). We now know that the 'Steyning for Trees' group will be planting their commemorative tree at Fletchers Croft.

At the last meeting the following motion was agreed

*Cllr Norcross **proposed, seconded** by Cllr S Alexander that the location that is shown in Abbey Road as per supporting papers is identified as a site for a tree installation either for the tree awarded to Steyning for Trees or if this is planted at Fletchers Croft, for another tree such as the one which may be forthcoming from the Women's Institute. **Agreed***

We have since received the following request.

Steyning Downlands WI would very much like to provide a Commemorative Tree as part of the Queen's Green Canopy to mark the life and Platinum Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II.

After consultation with Steyning Parish Council and "Steyning for Trees", we have chosen a Medium-size Field Maple (Acer Campestre), a native species of the British Isles.

We also propose to have a Tree Guard with a stake and a plaque for our tree.

We understand that it may be possible to have our tree on the Abbey Road site.

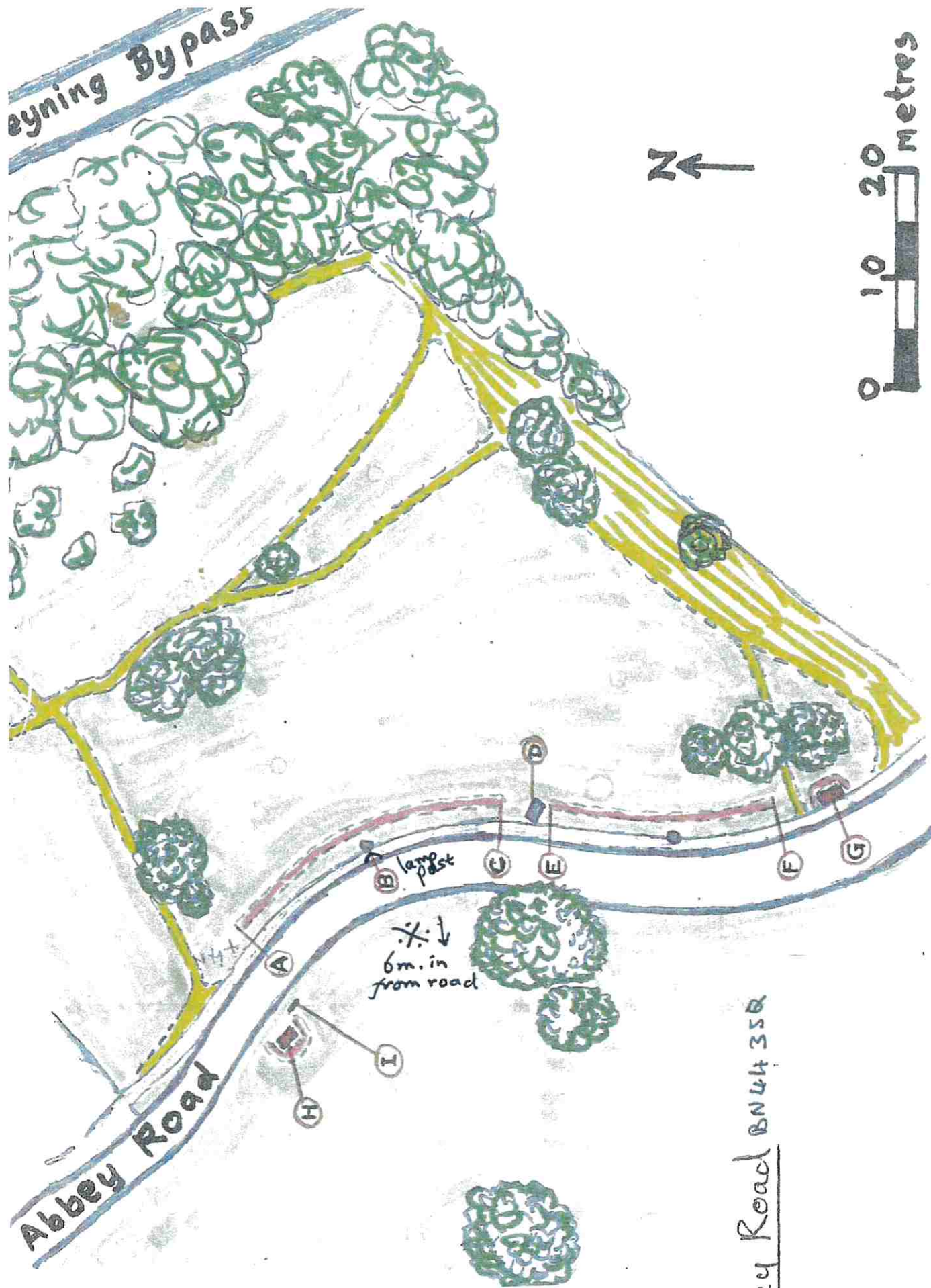
We ask for the support of SPC in achieving this project.
