

Requests from the Steyning Bowls Club

Briefing Note

At the recent Steyning Club Lease 'Premises checks' which were carried out by Premises committee members and in discussion with various club representatives, there were a number of requests, and the two that follow from the Bowls Club come under the delegated authority of the Community Committee to discuss and agree.

6.8 - Sycamore Tree Maintenance

The Bowls Club have requested that the Sycamore tree which is adjacent the MPF and on the southwest corner of their hedge-line be reduced by a similar amount to when these works were completed approx. 4 years ago. Using our SPC Tree Management Plan agreed at the last meeting – I have planned that this periodic tree surgery was to be completed next year, and asked our most frequently used (Steyning based) contractor if he could produce a quote for us. If we agree the quote noted below, I could ask that the contractor completes the work this financial year if budget allows or plan it for the following year if not. Quote noted as follows -

6.9 - Hedgerow Maintenance

The Bowls Club have requested that the Memorial Garden hedge that backs on to the bowling green is cut down to the same height as the adjacent hedge that backs onto the MPF. The heights currently differ by approximately 3 ft.

The contractor that does the annual maintenance and hedge and foliage cutting in the Memorial Garden has quoted £360.00 (a day's work for 2 men) to bring the hedge in line with the adjacent hedge. Could we agree or otherwise this works is completed please.
