Mr Fullbrook

You have claimed both publicly and privately that Fols from me are causing you to work excessive hours.

Yet it turns out that of the three, you have effectively done nothing with this one. Only yesterday you wrote claiming that you could not even trace my two request documents. Of the remaining two, one has been refused in exactly the same way as this one and the other you merely sent a handful of documents to all councillors which we should have had in the first place and the rest has also been rejected as supposedly covered by s32.

I received this message under reply only after I returned from work yesterday and so the less than four and a half hours you gave me to put argument to the Review Panel had already expired. This half a working day time limit which had already expired when I saw it is after you breached SPC's statutory duty by giving yourself no less than seventy-five working days to produce your one paragraph rejection, which I note is precisely what the Personnel Committee advised/instructed you to do at their meeting on 11 November 2021. Please now either let me have the four simple documents which should never have needed an Fol request, or let me know the Review Panel's decision and reasoning. Please also let me know who comprised the Panel
