

Briefing Note for items 7.2 and 7.3

7.2 - Current Highways issues

On the afternoon of the day of the meeting {the 7th February} the clerk is due a meeting with the County Councillor Paul Linehan, and the West Sussex Highways Officer to discuss issues flagged up by residents at both Shooting Fields (congestion), Church Road (parking) and safety of pedestrians (whilst walking along the Horsham road between the High street and the Sports Centre). The Clerk will update on any information arising from the meeting and members could discuss and agree any actions required.

7.3 – An update on current DMMO applications from SPC.

There are three DMMO's to consider under this item, and the clerk will update as per the following information.

1. ROW/3309393 - Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 – Schedule 14 - Order Making Authority: West Sussex County Council – Application for the addition of a path with two extensions connecting the Steyning Rifle Range, Footpath 2715 and Bridleway 2724 DMMO 4/21. Following the Parish Councils appeal to the Planning Inspectorate, West Sussex County Council have been informed of the appeal and requested to give a response. The next stage is for an Inspector to be appointed to consider the papers and write a decision. We will be informed once this has been done.

2. ROW/3291861 - Title of order: West Sussex County Council - Chanctonbury No 1 Steyning: A footpath from footpath 2704-1 and bridleway 2714 crossing Mouse Lane past Charlton Court.

The office received notification that this order has been submitted to the Secretary of State, and that the order will be determined by an inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. It will be dealt with by a written representation procedure. The Objections/representations and statements will be made available for public inspection in due course.

3. DMMO 4/20 - Definitive Map Modification Order application to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for Chanctonbury to add a footpath from Coombe Drove, Bramber to Bostal Road, Steyning in the parishes of Bramber and Steyning The application is being considered on Tuesday 7th February at County Hall, Chichester.
