

Briefing Note – To discuss and agree the movement of the SPC noticeboard.

Please see below part of the notes from the Bus Shelter working party – could we consider please whether we want to move the notice board from its current location – This has been an outstanding request from the Steyning in Bloom group for some considerable time and was one of the main reasons for our committee discussing any developments at the Bus Shelter in the first place.

I have had informal discussions with an HDC officer as to the possibilities of a movement involving the ticket machine being moved, but he wondered what would be the benefit to do so for the expenditure involved. Before taking the matter further officially therefore I wondered if this was a realistic agreement and worth pursuing or whether it was just one of many opinions on the matter aired during the working party discussions.

In other words, if you could consider the four options noted in the text below and come up with a preferred option I would much appreciate it.

2. SPC Notice Board

There were forthright views on the need to move the SPC Notice board if at all possible – so as to provide easier access to the adjacent flower bed – but where to place it instead?! It seemed there were four options – move it to the right and in front of the existing brick wall (This would need HDC approval and installation of posts) or adapt the existing Large Community Notice Board on the wall to the right of the Bus Shelter, however this would reduce the space available for community groups to advertise their sessions it seemed, or ask HDC to move their ticket machine to the brick wall adjacent the existing Notice board location and use the wall of the Bus Shelter for the SPC Notice Board (behind the machines current location), or not to move the Notice board at all. The favoured suggestion was to definitely move it, and to the position behind the current ticket machine, if at all possible, with the second choice being to move it to the right of its existing position, out of the flower bed, and in front of the brick wall. – It seemed the first necessity was to find out if a movement of the Ticket Machine was possible and could be undertaken by HDC.
