ASB crime

January has been a relatively quiet period in relation to Anti-Social Behaviour although we continue to monitor and patrol key hotspot areas.

January has seen an increase in Anti-Social driving in the Fletchers Croft Car Park. We have taken vehicle registration details and reported into Operation Crackdown. We received information via the Police relating to a particular vehicle that may be involved in drug dealing. We have seen this vehicle in the area and are feeding information back to the Police.

We continue to patrol and monitor the High Street Bus Shelter. There have been multiple occasions where groups of young people have been congregating there, but few reports of ASB Incidents.

We received a report of young people causing a nuisance in Upper Beeding Recreational grounds and potentially smoking cannabis. We've had reports of this nature recently & have been focusing our patrols in the area, engaging with young people who congregate on the bench next to the sports hall and a different group who gather in the Bandstand.

A resident reported an increase in drug dealing by vehicle in Bramber Castle Car Park. We have stepped up patrols of the area in response.

Additional Patrols Smugglers Lane re a Dog Fouling complaint.

Continued with patrols of regular hot spot areas such as The High Street Bus Shelter, Elm Grove Lane, Fletchers Croft Car Park, Bramber Castle car park & Upper Beeding Recreational grounds.

Older, vulnerable people and youth

Continuation of regular welfare visits & supporting the Warm Hub.

Dog related issues

Dog Fouling issue reported to us in Smugglers Lane, we put up signage in the area as there wasn't any existing. We have had no further reports but continue to monitor.
