(GODSTALLS LANE AMENDMENT) ORDER 202*

Permission has been granted to advertise a proposed Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to extend the lengths of prohibition of waiting at all times (double yellow lines) on Godstalls Lane, Steyning south of the junction with Newham Lane southwards by 10 metres on the east side and by 108 metres on the west side.

As part of the legal process West Sussex County Council is required under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, to undertake a formal consultation with you. I am pleased to attach a weblink. This will enable you to view:
