I'm sorry but I am not going to be spending any more of my time on this request.

I noted that one of the main reasons the ICO found in your favour in regards to the decision notice was that it would not place an unreasonable burden on the Council.

It has taken several days to locate, collate and provide you with the 225 pages of emails and other information supplied in our response thus far.

I note that the decision notice from the ICO stated that, and I quote

The Commissioner acknowledges that, if the complainant were to make further requests on the back of a response to this request, any such further correspondence could be deemed unreasonably persistent. The complainant is treading a fine line between requests that are vexatious and those which are not.

You did indeed ask for a further request on the back of our very detailed response, and without wanting to make an issue out of it, I replied to this request noted below.

I'm afraid I am drawing a line under this, as I consider your continued requests unreasonably persistent.

Of course, if you want to continue to pursue the matter with the ICO then please do so, and if they ask the Council to continue to respond then I will do so.
