



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Castle Lane, Bramber CP, 18th March 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Castle Lane, Bramber CP, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Castle Lane for a distance approx 304 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 18th March 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 22nd March 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while HRG Tree Surgeons undertakes daytime road closures between Castle Lane Roundabout and Roman Road for the removal, cutting/felling of dead and collapsed trees.

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 09:00 until 16:00
