



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Botolphs Road, Bramber CP, 3rd September 2025.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Botolphs Road, Bramber CP, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Botolphs Road for a distance approx 130 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 3rd September 2025 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 3rd September 2025) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Openreach undertakes a daytime road closure for works to replace a telecoms pole.

Road closed between the junctions with Maudlin Lane and A27, with works o/s Annington Old Farmhouse.

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 08:00 until 18:00

Access maintained for emergency services, residents and pedestrians.
