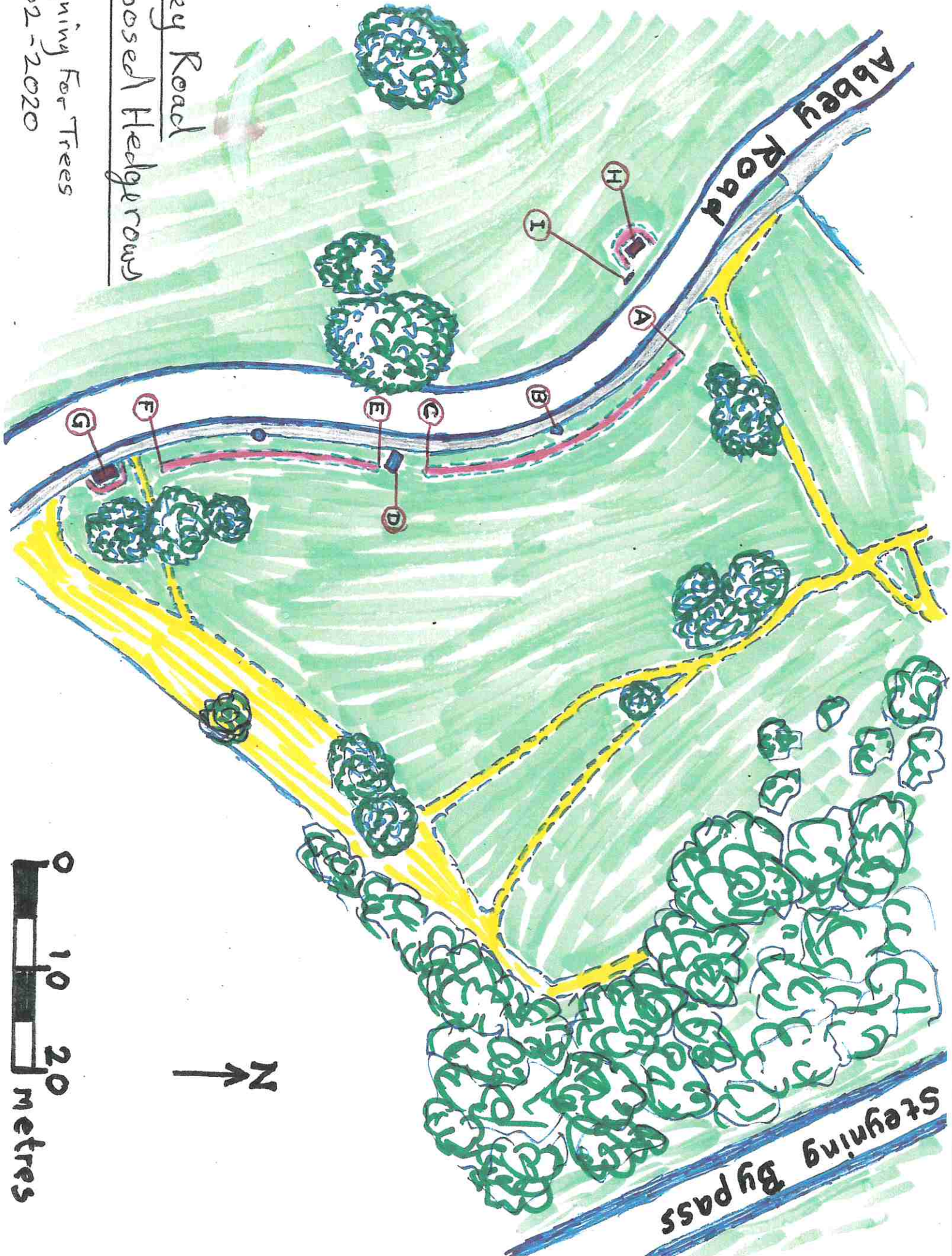

Abbey Road Proposed Hedge rows

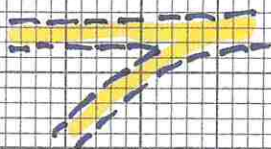
Key to Sketch Map



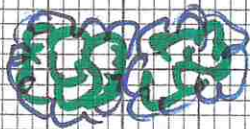
Hedge - 1 metre wide -
to be planted 2 m. in from pavement



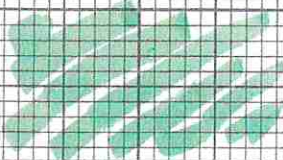
Tarmac pavement, east

Trees



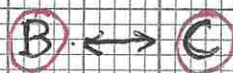
Open grassy areas

- (A) Northern end of hedge to Finish
~ 2 metres south of "Abbey Road" sign (I)
- (B) Lamp post
- (D) Bench - hedge to finish 3 metres north
of it (C) and restart 2 metres south (E).
- (F) Southern end of hedge
- (G) Green cabinet belonging to Southern Water.
- (H) Green cabinet belonging to British Gas.
- (I) "Abbey Road" sign

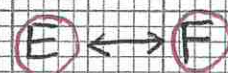
Approximate lengths of proposed hedge:-

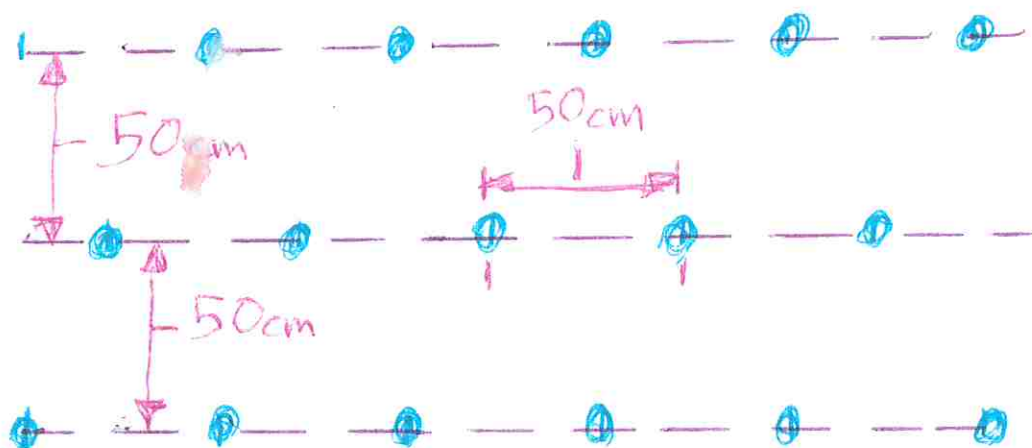

Total length of hedge = 44 metres



To plant triple rows
with tree saplings 50cm
apart, we need 7 plants/metre

Therefore 420 plants could
cover approx 60 metres
of hedgerow.
